

This **Transport Emergency Information Panel (EIP)** has black text on a white background with the specified class label as per the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road & Rail (ADG Code).

Material: Metal or Vinyl – 800 (W) x 600 (H) with the other dimensions as indicated.

- The Sodium Hydroxide (Caustic Soda) Bulk Transport (EIP) shall to be prominently displayed on the dangerous goods vehicle in the correct configuration as per the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road & Rail (ADG Code).
- In addition to the EIP a class label shall also be displayed on the front of the dangerous goods vehicle in the correct configuration as per the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road & Rail (ADG Code).
- Note: drivers and vehicles transporting IBCs do not require licensing if the total capacity on the vehicle is no more than 3,000 litres and receptacles are not filled or emptied on the vehicle.
