Special developer infrastructure contributions Australind

Background

In 1999, Australind wastewater treatment plant was decommissioned, and a new treatment plant was built at Kemmerton to provide an upgraded wastewater service.

Developers of land within the buffer zone of the Australind treatment plant, where a wastewater service is available, are required to pay special developer infrastructure contribution in addition to the standard infrastructure contribution. This is to offset the cost of relocating the wastewater treatment plant.

The contribution is payable on all new lots with sewerage available and is applicable at subdivision stage only. It is not subject to the GST.
