

# Broome – start of construction

## New pipeline construction

Water Corporation's authorised contractor Kimberley Civil and Drainage (KCD) will start construction of a new wastewater pipeline and irrigation pipeline extending from Town Beach to Broome International Airport in December. Please refer to the map over page that shows the work area.

### Why is this work happening?

The wastewater pipeline will transfer wastewater for processing to Broome North Water Resource Recovery Facility when Broome South Water Resource Recovery Facility (Broome South) is decommissioned. The irrigation water pipeline will provide groundwater to irrigate Broome's golf course and public open space. This will replace the treated wastewater currently being supplied by Broome South. This work is one of several projects underway in Broome to improve water and wastewater services. ### How will this impact me?

Construction work will be disruptive to people in the area. While we take care to minimise the impacts of the work, the community may notice noise, dust and activity in the area. Traffic management will be in place as required.

Some sections of the pipeline will cross over verges and driveways. Any area impacted by the work will be reinstated to its original condition as far as practicable. We will engage with you prior to such work occurring.

Unfortunately, the removal of some trees is unavoidable. We will replace any trees we remove, and we have liaised with Traditional Owners, the Shire of Broome and property owners.

### When will this happen?

Construction will start from **December 2021** and is expected to take six months to complete. The section of pipe near Broome Primary School will be completed first, during school holidays, to minimise community disruption.

Pipes located within verges will be laid by open trench construction methods. Pipes crossing major roads will be constructed using trenchless methods by horizontal drilling. This work will occur between 7am and 6pm Monday to Saturday. Night works will be required for the section of pipeline adjacent to the Broome International Airport.
