

Upcoming work

What is happening?

As part of our ongoing commitment to futureproof Perth's water supply, Water Corporation's authorised contractor, Benang, will soon be replacing water pipes near you.

The replacement of these pipes is essential to prevent future leaks and breaks and will help improve the security and reliability of the water supply to the area for decades to come.

When is this happening?

Work is planned to **begin mid-September 2024** on **Edna Street and Haig Street**, Tuart Hill. Each street is expected to take **5 - 7 weeks to complete**.

Work will be completed **Monday to Friday, 7am to 5pm**, and Saturdays as required. We will notify you again if we are required to work outside these hours.

Work along **Banksia Street, French Street, and Federal Street** will start once Haig and Edna Streets are complete. We will notify residents once we have a confirmed start date for this area.

Where is this happening?

- Work area 1: Edna Street and Haig Street, Tuart Hill (commencing mid-September)
- Work area 2: Banksia Street, French Street and Federal Street, Tuart Hill (start date to be advised)

The location of the pipe is shown in the below map.



How will this impact me?

Noise and dust

Noise and dust will be kept to a minimum however, construction will involve road cutting, excavating and compacting.

Traffic management

Each street will be closed to traffic while we install the new pipe, local residents will still be permitted to enter. Traffic management and personnel will be onsite to safely re-direct traffic around the work area.

Access

The new pipe will be installed in the road verge. Access will be interrupted for up to a day while we are completing the section of pipe directly out the front of each property. We will contact you ahead of time to organise access requirements for your property.

Reinstatement of verges and driveways

A temporary reinstatement of your driveway and road will be completed the same day and a permanent reinstatement upon completion of your street.

Please be assured that any affected area, including verges and driveways, will be reinstated as closely as possible to its condition prior to the work.

Water outage

There may be a temporary water supply interruption to your property during the work. We will contact you directly if your property is affected.

Connection pipe

As well as replacing the water pipe along this street, we may also be required to replace your connection pipe. This pipe runs between the new water pipe and your water meter. We will notify you ahead of time if we will renew your connect pipe.
