NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO CONSTRUCT A 60ML TREATED WASTEWATER STORAGE DAM AND IRRIGATION PUMP STATION



To improve the Mount Barker Treated Wastewater Management Scheme, Water Corporation proposes to construct:

- A new 60ML treated wastewater storage dam; and
- Irrigation pump station with filtration and disinfection system.

Decommissioning works will include:

- The existing two treated wastewater storage dams on the site, including their associated pump stations

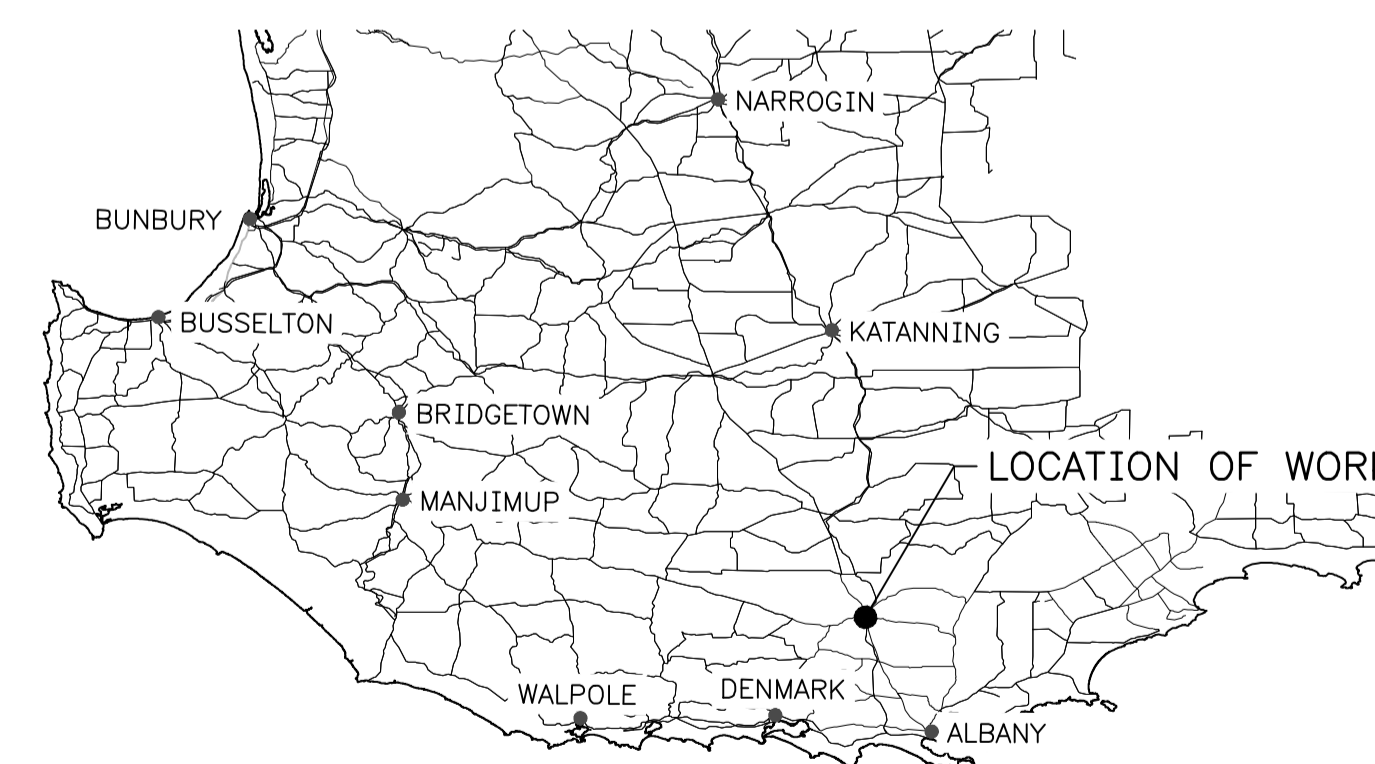
The works are contained within the existing Water Corporation owned woodlot site which includes Lots 5262, B21, 1367, 1611 and 2063.

The proposed works is scheduled to commence in late 2023 and continue for a duration of 20 months.
