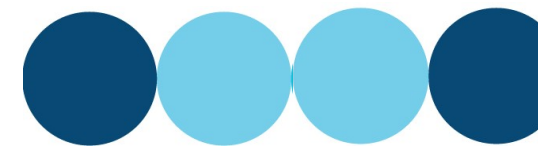


Water source upgrades in Shire of Donnybrook-Balingup



Notice of Proposal to upgrade Donnybrook bore and pipeline



Water Corporation proposes to carry out essential work to upgrade an existing bore and associated pipework to connect this new source to the surrounding water supply network.

The bore and pipeline will help secure Donnybrook's water supply for decades to come.

Construction is expected to begin in mid-2024 and could take up to 6 months to complete.

Scope of work includes:

- Upgrading an existing production bore at the existing Water Corporation site located within Donnybrook Golf Club.
- Constructing 1220 metres of buried water pipeline from production bore to the existing network along Bakewell Street, and Bentley Street in Donnybrook.
- Full restoration of impacted areas.

Construction of buried pipelines will be carried out mostly by open excavation techniques.

Construction is dependant on all required approvals.

Objections to proposed work will be considered if lodged in writing, addressed to the Project Manager Water Corporation, Mr Latif Geldard-Ker, at P.O. Box 100, Leederville WA 6902, before close of business, within 21 days of the date of the attached letter.
