

# Revegetation Plan

## Osborne Park Drain Upgrade



Thank you to all residents who put forward their suggestions for the revegetation plan.

28 semi-mature trees (14L and 35L root size) will be planted west and east of the drain, along with 417 tree, shrub, and ground cover seedlings. All species are Western Australian that are native to the Swan Coastal Plain area.

The revegetated area will be covered with composted coarse native mulch to support the growth of the newly planted vegetation and help with weed suppression.

Large trees will be planted at least 10m from residential fences to prevent falling branches and to minimise fire risk to properties once trees are fully established. A 5m area between the revegetation zone and nearby residents fencelines will also be covered with mulch and kept clear of any vegetation to create a fire break.

Compacted limestone will be installed close to Pearson Street to allow Water Corporation access to the drain for future maintenance. Access to the drain will be gated and locked for public safety.
