What is happening in your area?

We are progressing well with the installation of the new water pipe in Wittenoom Street (between Bennett Street and Plain Street) and we're on track for completion by early 2025. This project will secure the supply of water in the City of Perth.

Our authorised contractor, DM Civil, will soon commence work to permanently resurface Wittenoom Street. This work requires **full road closure of Wittenoom Street (between Bennett and Plain Streets) for up to 2 days**. Further details below:


Wittenoom Street resurfacing – important information

On **Monday 2 and Tuesday 3 December**, between 7am – 5pm, Wittenoom Street is scheduled to be resurfaced.

All on-street parking will be closed in each of the above scheduled dates. Please arrange alternative parking for your vehicle from the night prior to these scheduled works, and for the subsequent days of work.

A full closure is required to ensure the resurfacing and line marking is completed without obstruction.

Local traffic can access Wittenoom Street via the westbound parking lane. The detour map is below:

We work closely with the City of Perth to ensure all reinstatements are carried out to the required standard.

As with any construction work, delays may occur once work commences. We will provide timely updates if we expect any significant change to the above schedule.

We understand and appreciate that this essential work may cause temporary inconveniences and disruption, and we will do what we can to minimise impacts where we can.

How will this impact me?

As with any construction activities, there will be an increase in vehicle movement, noise and dust in the area. Traffic management personnel be on-site to direct vehicles and pedestrians safely around the work area.

Property access will be maintained throughout most of the work; however, some properties will have temporary access restrictions to their driveways for up to 1 day. If your property is impacted, we will contact you in advance to ensure minimal disruption.

We will aim to keep impacts to the community to a minimum wherever possible and keep the area tidy. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation whilst this essential work takes place.
