

# Wittenoom Street

## Project update

### What is happening in your area?

We are progressing well with the installation of the new water pipe in Wittenoom Street (between Bennett Street and Plain Street) and have completed 80% of the planned work. This project will secure the supply of water in the City of Perth. Thank you for your patience in the last few months while we undertook this essential work.

The final piece of work is connecting the new pipeline into the existing water network both at Bennett and Plain Street intersections. This work will be construction via open trenching, meaning we will be digging up the intersection and / or surrounding footpaths. This work will also require isolating our water service to safely connect the pipe to our network.

Due to the significant expected impact from this work, these intersection connections have now been delayed until April/ May 2025. The exact dates will be confirmed closer to the time. This rescheduled timeframe will allow the work to be done in the cooler months, lowering the risk of any water pressure or supply issues while we undertake this work.

This week, our authorised contractor, DM Civil will pack down their site compound and tidy up the site area. This will include some temporary reinstatement at Plain and Bennett Street intersections.

There will be no construction work from Friday 20 December until we restart work later in 2025.

Thank you for your patience and understanding until this work can take place.
