

# Ashfield water pipeline upgrades

## Project update

### What is happening?

Our authorised contractor, DMC are progressing well with the installation of the new water pipeline near the Ashfield Train Station, which will replace the existing pipeline. This project will help to shape WA's water future by securing the supply of water to Ashfield and Bassendean.

Part of the work requires microtunnelling from our two pits at Ashfield Reserve and Railway Pde. To allow adequate space for machinery and equipment, we have temporarily closed one lane on Railway Pde and Guildford Rd. The footpaths around this area also have intermittent interruptions and detours.

Traffic management signage and personnel will be on-site to direct vehicles and pedestrians safely around the work area.

### When is this happening?

Work will continue taking place on **Monday to Saturday between 7am and 5pm**. The expected completion date for this project is end of May 2025.

### What should I expect?

**As with any construction activities, there will be an increase in vehicles, noise and dust in the area.**

We will aim to keep impacts to the community to a minimum wherever possible and keep the area tidy.

We thank you for your understanding and cooperation whilst this essential work takes place.
